1. Distribute the student leadership application to those who express interest in serving. (www.nencfca.org)
2. Review collected leadership applications and make selections by getting the “right people in the right roles.” (See Ideal Leadership doc)
3. Have the entire leadership team (students & adults) complete Campus 101 training (www.fcacampus101.com).
4. Participate as a leadership team in our local Leadership Kickoff. (Sept 8th)
5. Promote the opportunity to serve as a leader in FCA on your campus for the next school year. (By March 15th)
6. Give new leaders the opportunity to shadow current leaders in their newly selected roles and responsibilities. (May)
7. Encourage student leaders to attend Leadership Camp at UNC-W this summer & register online. (By May 15th)
